ATOMIC APPOINTS GENERAL MANAGER

Atomic Resources Limited (ASX Code: ATQ) (“Atomic”), is pleased to announce the appointment of Ray Baily as General Manager for the Tanzanian Coal Projects. Mr Baily comes to the group with extensive experience in coal mining and production. His recent position was General Manager of PT Suprabari Mapanindo Mineral (Indonesia), one of Indonesia’s largest coal mining companies. Prior to his recent role, Mr Baily has had extensive project and mining experience with BHP (Phillipines), Copper Resources Corporation (Democratic Republic of Congo) and Halliburton (Australia).

His strong senior Project role and successful management of a number of development projects internationally, combined with his mining and legal professional qualifications makes him ideal for the role.

Mr Baily’s priority is to move towards coal production at Ngaka, Tanzania over the coming months through the completion of the Bankable Feasibility Study (“BFS”). He will also help the company build further coal resources and new energy projects in the longer term.

The BFS is examining the feasibility of developing a 3-4 Mtpa coal mining operation at Ngaka, and includes coal exports and the development of an on-site “clean coal” 400 megawatt power station, which will increase Tanzania’s domestic power supplies by 40%. The Ngaka coal project is one of the largest and most important “nation building” projects in Tanzania and enjoys the strong support of the Tanzanian Government, which has a 30% direct interest in the Ngaka Project through its joint venture with Atomic Resources.
